Explanation:

I don't know **if (whether)** Meanie wants to go to the carnival.

3. false

2 marks

Explanation:

Yippee is a word expressing wild excitement or delight.

Example: **Yippee!** We have arrived at our beach cottage!

4. C: because

4 marks

Explanation:

My report shows good results **because (for the reason that)** I work hard at my school work.

5. C: when

4 marks

Explanation:

The dog was running across the road **when (after which)** the car screeched to a halt.

6. wow | wow.

3 marks

Explanation:

Wow - shows excitement

7. true

2 marks

Explanation:

Gee is a word that is used to express surprise, wonder or excitement.

Example:

Gee, I did not expect such a big present!

8. B: Oops

4 marks

Explanation:

Oops is used when you have made a mistake or a small accident has occurred. It is also used when you apologise for a mistake.

In this sentence the person is saying that it was an accident - the ice-cream was not pushed off the cone on purpose.

Oops, I am so sorry that I made you fall.

9. B: or

4 marks

Explanation:

It is a choice.

You must choose one option, therefore the conjunction is **OR** and not **and**.

10. whether | while

4 marks

Explanation:

whether: this conjunction is used to introduce a choice.
The choice here is between Mauritius and Greece.

while: during that time

During the time that it takes my parents to page through the brochures, I will play with my friends.
