Explanation:

FEW is an adjective of quantity. It tells us how much of something there is.

2. A: common noun 4 marks

Explanation:

The ordinary names which are given to all people, places and things of the same kind are called common nouns.

3. bitterly 3 marks

Explanation:

BITTERLY describes the verb CRIED. It tells us how the girl cried.

4. will | auxiliary verb 4 marks

Explanation:

WILL helps to tell us when Sally will PLAY the leading role.

5. false 2 marks

Explanation:

LOUDLY is an adverb.

It describes the verb "laughed". It tells us HOW the father laughed.

6. true 2 marks

Explanation:

MORE COMFORTABLE describes the noun CHAIR.

7. worst | most exciting 4 marks

Explanation:

Long adjectives sound awkward if -ER and -EST are added, so we use MORE and MOST instead.

8. pride | cast | flight

6 marks

Explanation:

A group of things of the same kind is called a collective noun.

9. true

2 marks

Explanation:

A proper noun names a particular noun, eg. Cape Town.

10. true

2 marks

Explanation:

The phrase tells us more about the man.
