Natural disasters happen suddenly. In 2004 an undersea earthquake caused a huge tidal wave called a tsunami and over 200 000 people died. In 2011 a tsunami hit Japan and damaged a nuclear plant. When volcanoes erupt, molten lava flows down and ash and rocks are thrown high into the air. This makes it unsafe for planes to fly. Heavy rain may cause floods. A famine is when there is no rain and food is scarce. South Africa has floods and droughts, but we do not have volcanoes or serious earthquakes.

Animals and creatures that help us

We get food and clothes from animals. Shoes and jackets are made from the leather hides of cattle and we use wool from sheep to knit jerseys. 
