1. B: manner

4 marks

Explanation:

ANGRILY tells us about HOW he waited, therefore it is an adverb of manner.

2. false

2 marks

Explanation:

WENT is a verb. It is the past tense for the verb IS GOING.

3. blowing | past tense

4 marks

Explanation:

The wind was blowing.

This sentence is in the past tense because it refers to something that already happened.

4. adverb | adverb of place

3 marks

Explanation:

Words which tell us where an action (verb) took place are called adverbs.

5. C: an adverb

4 marks

Explanation:

It tells us WHEN the action took place, therefore it is an adverb of time.

6. shall | travel

4 marks

Explanation:

I SHALL, we SHALL, everyone else WILL.

Yesterday we travelled. Today we travel. Tomorrow we shall travel.

7. D: adverb

4 marks

Explanation:

Words which describe actions (the verbs) are called adverbs.

QUICKLY is an adverb of manner.

8. ate | swam

4 marks

Explanation:

We will write the sentence like this in the present tense:
After school we EAT our lunch and then SWIM in the pool

9. shall | helping verb

4 marks

Explanation:

In the future tense SHALL is used with I and WE.
SHALL helps to tell us when " I " will VISIT Ross.
(This is not a hard and fast rule.)

10. C: place

4 marks

Explanation:

EVERYWHERE tells us about WHERE they have looked.
