1. I | our

4 marks

Explanation:

My brother and (...) just finished brushing (...) teeth.

Pronouns replace nouns in a sentence. Instead of using the name of the person (this sentence is written in 1st person narration), the pronoun "**I**" is used.

The second pronoun refers to both brothers which shows that it is plural, "**our**".

2. they | it

4 marks

Explanation:

They (a third person/group pronoun as a subject) could not find their house, because **it** (replaces an object) magically disappeared.

3. B: he

4 marks

Explanation:

The word "Joe" is replaced by the pronoun "he".

4. she | "she"

3 marks

Explanation:

Lily is a proper noun. It should be replaced by the pronoun "she".

5. false

2 marks

Explanation:

The definite article in this sentence is "the".

6. He | "he"

3 marks

Explanation:

Pronouns replace nouns, therefore they are **naming words**. If you got confused and typed the word "his" as the pronoun, it would be incorrect, because in THIS sentence the word "his" describes the work. This makes "his" an adjective. There is only **one pronoun in this sentence** and that is the word "he".

7. he | her

4 marks

Explanation:

Prince Charming wandered into the woods to find Cinderella, but **he** (*3rd person male pronoun as the subject of the sentence*) could not find **her** (*3rd person female pronoun as the object*).

8. she | it

4 marks

Explanation:

Kylie enjoys playing the piano (...) plays (...) daily.

Kylie is a proper noun. The word "she" is a female pronoun that replaces the proper noun "Kylie" in the sentence.

The word "it" is a pronoun that replaces an object in the sentence.

9. we | "We"

3 marks

Explanation:

The word "we" refers to a group of people that includes the narrator as well.

10. false

2 marks

Explanation:

This is a trick question, as *his* can be a pronoun. However in this sentence "his" is a *possessive adjective*.

A pronoun takes the place of the noun such as "**he**" in this sentence.
