The word "imaginatively" describes the manner in which something is created and the word "yesterday" refers to a time of day.

5. A: everywhere 4 marks

**Explanation:**

EVERYWHERE is the only adverb on the list referring to a place.

6. degree | place 4 marks

**Explanation:**

If something is ALMOST done, it shows to **what degree** it is done.

UP shows **where** we are going.

7. false 2 marks

**Explanation:**

Very is an adverb of degree.

---

8. degree | adverb of degree

3 marks

**Explanation:**

The word "completely" is an adverb of degree, as it shows to what degree the bag was filled.

---

9. degree | adverb of degree

3 marks

**Explanation:**

The word VERY shows the degree to which the water is hot.

---

10. degree | manner

4 marks

**Explanation:**

The word 'well' can refer to in what **way** something is done and to what **degree** it is done.
