4. can't | it's 4 marks

Explanation:

She cannot (can't) go to the park because it is (it's) raining.

5. they'll | "they'll" 3 marks

Explanation:

In the contraction of they and will, the apostrophe replaces the "wi" in will: they'll.

6. A: they're 4 marks

Explanation:

In the contraction of they and are, the apostrophe replaces the "a" in are: they're.

7. he'll 3 marks

Explanation:

In the contraction of he and will, the apostrophe replaces the "wi" in will: he'll.

8. true

2 marks

Explanation:

Will not becomes won't. The two words are simplified into one word.

9. shouldn't

3 marks

Explanation:

In the contraction of should and not, the apostrophe replaces the "o" in not: shouldn't.

10. A: we'd

4 marks

Explanation:

In the contraction of we and would, the apostrophe replaces all four letters "woul" in would:
we'd.
