4 marks

Explanation:

I = personal pronoun

to = infinitive

Therefore, the 2 prepositions are 'by' and 'of'.

2.
indefinite

6 marks

| oneself | reflexive

Explanation:

one = indefinite (people referred to in a general way)

oneself = reflexive (refers back to the pronoun)

3. I | you

4 marks

Explanation:

A personal pronoun refers to people or things.

'You' and 'I' are personal pronouns.

4. infinitive | verb

4 marks

Explanation:

Infinitive = to + verb

Examples: to sing, to jump

5. true

2 marks

Explanation:

Reflexive pronouns end in '-self' and refer back to the noun or pronoun already mentioned.

Example: He bought himself a bag.

6. D: verb and preposition

4 marks

Explanation:

This is a verb and preposition functioning together: 'grow up'. 'grow up' is a prepositional phrasal verb.

7. along | along.

3 marks

Explanation:

The correct preposition is 'along'.

It shows position between 'me' and 'shopping'.

8. across. | across

3 marks

Explanation:

The correct preposition is 'across'.

It shows position / place between 'we' and 'street'.
