The noun 'Daniel' can be replaced by the pronoun 'he'.

3. with | with.

Explanation:

A preposition connects nouns and pronouns.

The preposition 'with' cannot be used to end a sentence.

4. B: manner

4 marks

Explanation:

An **adverb of manner** modifies a verb by describing how the action is performed. Most adverbs of manner end in -ly.

5. auxiliary | helping

4 marks

Explanation:

An auxiliary verb assists another verb in the sentence by indicating tense.

6. adjective | ownership

4 marks

Explanation:

Possessive adjectives describe ownership of the noun.

Example:

He used **my** pen to write the exam.

7. I. | I

3 marks

Explanation:

The subject of the sentence usually appears at the beginning of the sentence (in active voice).

8. proper | place

4 marks

Explanation:

A proper noun will always start with a capital letter.

9. true

2 marks

Explanation:

An adverb describes how, when, where, how often and to what degree a verb is done.

10. cards | cards.

Explanation:

The object refers to the aspect that the action is being done to.
